Despite the accumulated fatigue after 9 months sailing around the world, Chris Nicholson and the 10 members that together, make up our heroic crew, crossed the finish line in first place in Galway during the early hours Tuesday morning. The long-awaited Volvo Ocean Race Leg victory arrived and also put enough points between CAMPER and the rest of the boats to guarantee a second place in the leaderboard.

The force of will and determination of CAMPER's crew was also rewarded with victory in the IWC Schaffhausen Speed Record Challenge of the Volvo Ocean Race 2011-2012, feat that was achieved by sailing a total of 564 nautical miles in 24 hours on June 14, during Leg 8 between Lisbon and Lorient.
